Althea Frances (DeVencenty) Bartolo, 96, was welcomed into the arms of the Lord on Wednesday, April 12, 2023. She is preceded in death by her husband, Pete Bartolo; father, Dominick DeVencenty; mother, Nellie (Salimeno) DeVencenty; brother, Joseph (Mary) DeVencenty, Aldo (Katherine) DeVencenty; in-laws, Peter (Bernice) Bartolomucci; brother-in-law, Joe Bartolo; and sister-in-law, Marie (Joe) Marcovecchio. Althea is survived by her loving son, Aaron Bartolo; numerous nieces, nephews, cousins, and great nieces, and nephews and loving friends which she had a special relation with each. She was affectionately called “Grammy” by Chanel, daughter of Jeff and Roxann James. Althea was born on August 29, 1926, to Dominick and Nellie (Salimeno) DeVencenty in Pueblo, and was raised out on the St. Charles Mesa on the family farm. Althea graduated from Pleasant View in 1944 and went to Pueblo Business College to pursue secretarial work. Althea worked at Walter’s Brewery before going to work at St. Mary Corwin in medical records and retired as the Tumor Registrar, where she made lifelong friends. While Althea worked at Classy Cleaners, she met Pete Bartolo and went on to marry him in November of 1952. They had one son, Aaron, in August of 1959. Althea was best known for her loving demeanor and valued family and friendships and was known for her youthful and energetic personality. Some of her favorite memories were made in her home visiting with her loving family and friends, with her beloved dog, Bella by her side. She loved to cook, and was famously known for her Italian sauce, and “banonos”, which coined her

nickname "Momma B." She was a devoted Catholic, she went on many catholic retreats and spent many hours praying the rosary. She was able to fulfill a lifelong dream of visiting the Holy Land with her sister-in-law, Kay DeVencenty.
