



Bernice Katherine Krasovec

August 8, 1928 - January 10, 2023

Bernice Katherine Krasovec passed away peacefully on January 10th, 2023, in Pueblo Colorado. She was born August 8, 1928, to Mike and Mary Hiza. She is predeceased by her parents, twin sister MaryAnn, and brother Michael Jr.

Bernice was devoted to her family, her church, and her community. She was an author of two children's books, the Curator of the Gornick Slovenian Library, Museum and Genealogy Center and founder of the St Mary's Prayer Garden. She was a faithful member of KSKJ, Slovenian Union of America, and St. Mary's Catholic Church. Her heritage and love for God and family was built to share. She was a dedicated volunteer - always showing up to help the church, her family, and the community. She loved flowers - especially her roses and was a blue-ribbon winner for her Potica. She was an avid writer and never missed sending a poem to her husband and children on Valentine's Day. Her smile and her positive attitude carried her through all times, and it opened hearts and allowed people to see the goodness of life. As a loving daughter, wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, and friend she will always be remembered as a woman of few words -saying "Thank You" for the smallest task and a reminder to "go with the flow."

Bernice married Rudolph Krasovec Sr., in 1948 and had 51 loving years together before his passing (1999).
