Chuck graduated from Central High School in Pueblo and went on to serve in the U.S. Navy. He studied Business, earning his Bachelor's Degree from Colorado University. He returned to Pueblo to help run and eventually became the owner and operator of Martin Music, Martin Music Student Center and MarGas. He was a member of Al Kaly Shrine, Pueblo Historical Society and Bessemer Historical Society. Chuck loved the outdoors and spent time snow skiing, riding his Enduro through the mountain trails, boating, water skiing, having taught his children these skills. Up until this last year, he was still walking 2 miles a day around his neighborhood. He enjoyed History, the U.S. Navy and telling his grandkids about life while he was growing up. But, his favorite pastime was traveling the World with his beloved Joanne. Preceded in death by his parents, Hobson and Mary Martin, his brother, Robert Martin; brother in-law, Frank Carey; and sister, Katherine "Katie" Carey.
