Daniel Martinez, also known as Dancin' Winter Hawk, died January 9th, 2026 at Parkview Medical Center after a fulfilling 84 years of life. Dancin was born December 31, 1941 in Red Wing, Colorado to Benjamin and Maria Nieves Martinez. He is preceded in death by both parents, his brother Edmond David Martinez, and his sister Cindy Miller. Dancin' is survived by his sister Norma Jean Cordova (Don). He is also survived by his 13 children spread out between three marriages and includes numerous nieces, nephews, grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and great-great grandchildren. Daniel is a veteran of the United States Army where he served as a combat medic. He retired from the Colorado State Hospital (CMHIP) where he worked as a psychiatric technician for over 20 years. Dancin' fought a 82 year battle with alcohol addiction. He missed celebrating his 42nd year of sobriety at the Great Escape due to failing health, unfortunately. Days were spent going on morning walks in the park and enjoying the local flea market and thrift stores. His days always included the afternoon AA meeting (The Nooner) at the Escape to practice the 12-step program. He had many friends at these meetings, many of whom visited him in his last days. Dancin' will be greatly missed by family, friends, and Kowalski, his feline companion. A Memorial service will be held Saturday, January 24th, 2026 at 10:00 A.M. at the Broadway Christian Church located on 206 Broadway Ave. Pueblo, CO. Reception will follow immediately at the same location.

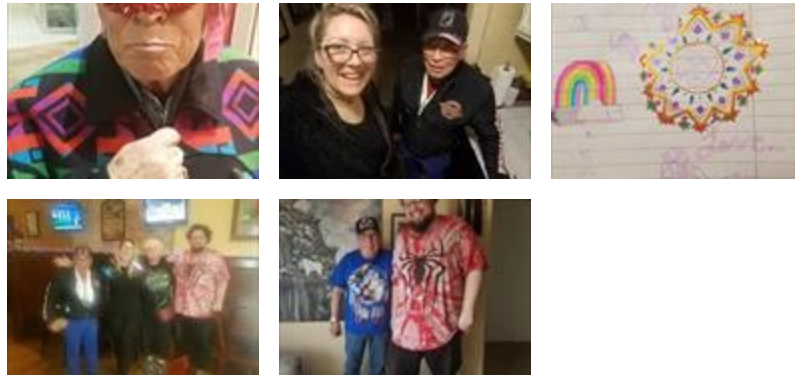
