



## Jane Grace Spulak

September 27, 1924 - March 19, 2013

Jane Grace Spulak, 88, passed away on March 19, 2013 of Parkinson's disease, in Pueblo, Colorado. She was preceded in death by her husband of 49 years, Robert George Spulak, parents, and two sisters. She is survived by her children, Linda Dianne Exline (and son-in-law Max I. Exline) of Pueblo, Colorado; Dr. Robert George Spulak, Jr. (and daughter-in-law DeAnna M.
