



## Master Sgt Jeffrey Scott Hambric

Jeffrey Scott Hambric, 50, of Pueblo, CO, peacefully passed away on Aug. 27, 2018. He was born May 30, 1968. He is survived by his loving wife of 23 years, Christine (Gallant) Hambric; children, Brynn Hambric (age 10), Reece Hambric (age 8); parents, William T. 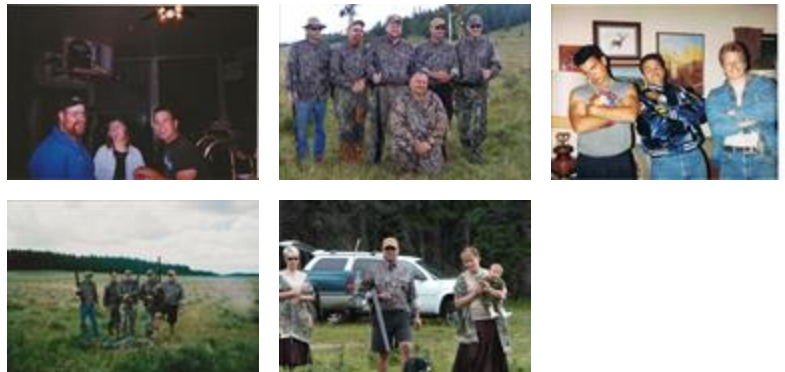
