On the morning of January 8th, 2026, after a long fought battle with melanoma, John Robert Moran was called home to his heavenly Father. He was surrounded by friends and family. John was born on June 24th, 1969, in Pueblo, Colorado. He was the youngest son of Joseph and Janice Moran, who both preceded him in death, in 2025 and 2022 respectively. On August 21st, 1993, John married the love of his life and college sweetheart, Erica, and they raised two strong and fantastic children. John was a Pueblo Centennial sports legend, playing years of football for the Bulldogs, with the reputation of being a gentle giant. John continued on to play 4 years as a defensive end and outside linebacker for Colorado State University. An avid Rams fan for life, John, or “Bam-Bam,” shared his love for football and CSU with his children. John loved to travel with his family, and cheer on his kids at their sporting events. Throughout Pueblo, if not for football, John is known for being a real estate developer and owning a branch of Windows for America. He is survived by his wife Erica; son Lukas; daughter Raelynn. He is also survived by his brother, Michael Moran and family, in addition to his sister, Lynne Moran and sister, Perla Askew.
