Joseph (Joe) Sam Geonetta, loving and dedicated father passed peacefully at home gaining his angel's wings on August 22, 2022. Joe was born in Los Angeles, CA on February 16, 1934, to the late Sam and Esther Geonetta. He graduated from Centennial High School, Pueblo, CO and soon after enlisted in the U.S. Airforce on March 20, 1953, as a Radio Traffic Interceptor stationed at Kelly AFB, San Antonio, TX and was Honorably discharged on March 19, 1957. He earned numerous awards and decorations to include the National Defense Medal, United Nations Service Medal, Good Conduct Medal, and the Korean Service Medal. He ultimately settled in Pueblo, CO and retired from Pepsi Cola. They made a life in the Philippines and lived there for over 20 years. They were extremely active and became a vital team in the local community. 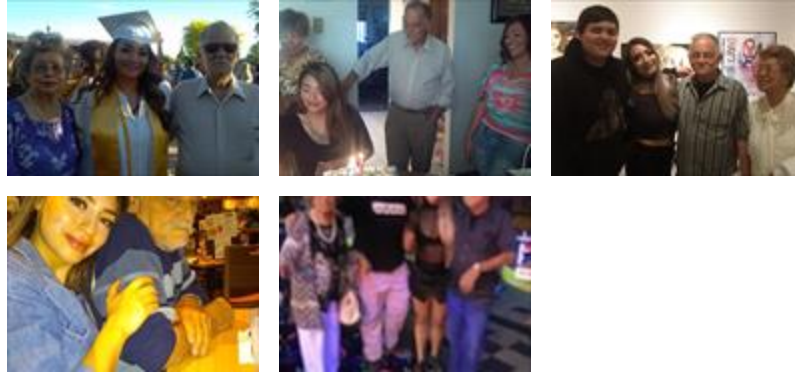

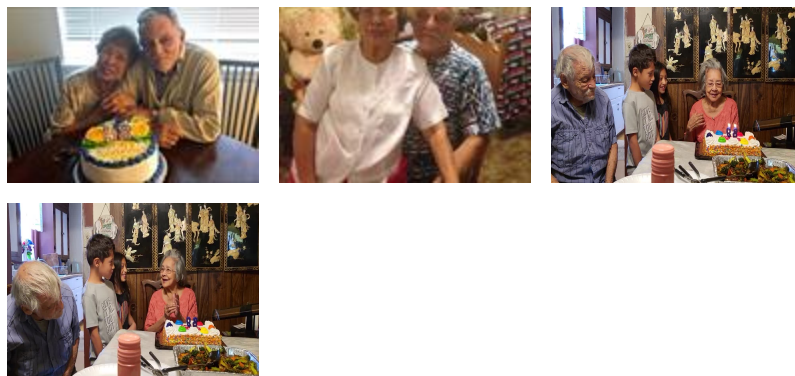

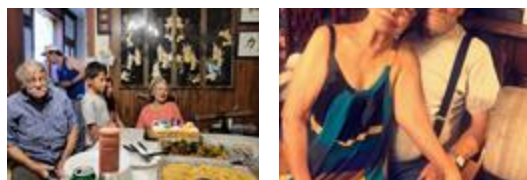
