Larry Max Jesser was born to Cleeta June and Harvey John Jesser in Lamar, Colo., on June 23, 1946. Larry grew up on the family farm near Pritchett and Springfield, Colo. Larry and his brothers Tim, Keith and Steven helped work the farm. Larry was several years older than his brothers, but he was a much loved big brother. Larry went to school in Pritchett where he played basketball, sang in the chorus, was manager of the basketball team and served on the student council. He graduated in 1964. Larry enjoyed singing solos at the United Methodist Church. Larry attended college in Trinidad, Colo., where he studied to be an electrician. Larry worked at Pueblo Power Company until he retired after 41 years and was a member of the Pueblo IBEW Union #667. Larry married Lee Fox in 1966, and had their son Raymond in Trinidad in 1967, after completing college. Larry's son Raymond Lawrence Jesser, of Yuma, Ariz. is married to Maria Catalina and they have three sons- Ronald, Joshua and Matthew. Raymond is a pastor at Yuma First Church of the Nazarene. After retiring, Larry moved to Yuma, Ariz., to spend more time with Raymond and his family. Larry married Dixie Lea Bray, in 1970, who had several children of her own. They were married for more than 25 years until she passed away suddenly due to a failing heart. Larry was also married shortly to Veronica Huskins and Laura Bevens. Larry passed away Dec. 16, 2022, in Yuma, Ariz., at the age of 76. He was preceded in death by his parents; and brother, Steven. Larry is remembered fondly and will be greatly missed.
