Lisa Karlyn Baker of Pueblo, Colorado died of lung cancer at her home January 16, 2026. She passed peacefully in her sleep accompanied by family.

Lisa was born in Council Bluffs, Iowa in 1954 to Earl Franklin Baker and Lois Jean Burch. She grew up as a military brat, attending schools across several states before graduating high school in Prescott, Arizona in 1972. She earned multiple university degrees including a bachelor's degree in nursing and a doctorate in theology. She was a nurse in the U.S. Army and retired as a registered nurse.

Lisa spent a lifetime caring for others as evidenced by her work as both a nurse and an ordained minister and wedding officiant. In her later years she adopted her late nephew's children, Levi and Savannah.

Lisa had a passion for medieval history and was a member of the Society for Creative Anachronism, a living history group.

She was preceded in death by her parents, her brother Earl Franklin Baker II, and her daughter Rebecca Listol-Dickson. She is survived by her adopted children Levi and Savannah, her grandchildren Andrew Listol and Nicole Dickson, several great-grandchildren, and her former husband and caretaker Frederick Kester.

A memorial service is Feb. 6 at 1 p.m. at King of Kings Lutheran Church, 2561 Vinewood Ln., Pueblo, Colorado. A celebration of life is planned for a unspecified date in the spring
