Mike Fossceco joined his wife and the angels in heaven on December 23, 2022. He was born August 11, 1933 in Pueblo Colorado. Mike is survived by son, Michael (Virginia) Fossceco; daughter, Cheryl (Jon) Klein; grandchildren, Anthony Fossceco, Devin (Kevin) Capra, Michelle (Dalton) Kent and Johanna Klein, DVM; great grandchildren, Kylie Capra, Kennedy Capra and Karter Capra.
