Pattie Ruth (Meadors) Adams, Beloved Mother, Grandmother and friend passed away January 8, 2021 at Memorial Hospital North, in Colorado Springs, at the age of 91.

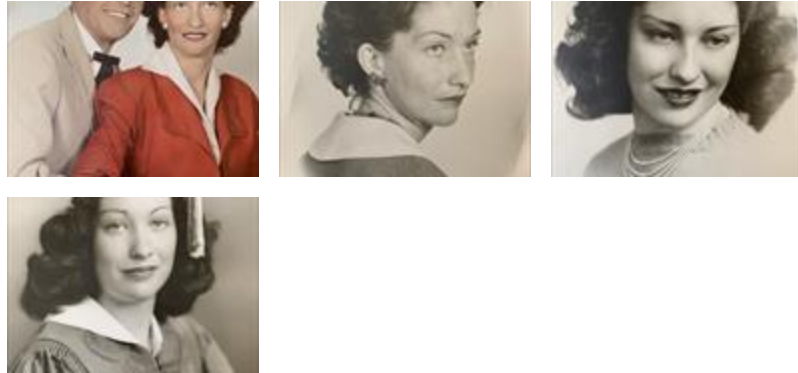

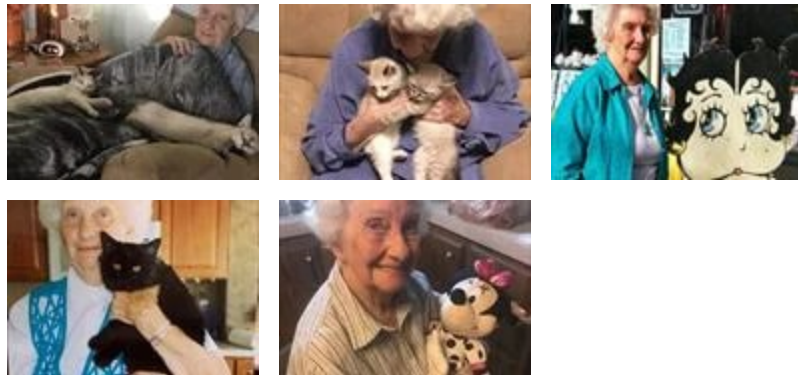
