Rick was the owner of Pueblo Welding & Fabrication Inc., a company he founded in February of 1999. He grew a successful business solely through reputation and word of mouth. He believed in doing right by people, never turning anyone away, and earning trust through honesty, and most importantly, his impeccable craftsmanship. The work he produced reflected a man who held a great deal of knowledge, a rare skillset, and the drive to relentlessly work hard. Rick was deeply passionate about aviation. He maintained his pilot’s license for over 25 years, flying in his pastime. In his early 60’s he bought and restored his own plane. Though his time to enjoy flying it was cut short, he delighted in every moment spent restoring his aircraft and the few short flights he was able to take in it. Above all, Rick was a faithful and loving husband to his wife, Elizabeth, with whom he shared 44 years of marriage. He was the best father anyone could ask for, survived by his three daughters, Lindsey (Nick Lile) McNamara, Kelsey (Abe Aryan) McNamara Aryan, and Haley (Cody Mittino) McNamara. He is also survived by his Mother, Rose McNamara-Connell, step-father Ron Connell, and brothers Randy and Russ McNamara. He was preceded in death by his father, Richard F. McNamara.
