Robert "Bobby" Lee Williams, 87 passed away at Parkview Hospital after a brief illness. Bobby is preceded in death by his daughter, Leanne; parents Rose and Henry Williams; in-laws Russell and Josephine Cascio; sisters Ruth Williams, Betty (Bud) Comfort; brothers Norman Raymond, and Henry Williams; sisters-in-law Rose Patrick, Dolly Mallard, Sara Thomas; brother-in-law Sonny Cascio; nephews Buddy Comfort, Tommy and Donny Mallard. Bobby is survived by his loving wife of 63 years, Joanne and his daughter Michele Hubbard; sister, Sandi (Jim) Cardinal and several nieces, nephews, great nieces, great nephews and extended family members. Bobby was born and raised in Pueblo on the Mesa and grew up on the family farm. As a young man he ran the family farm working with his family where he was often seen in the fields on the tractor, pulling rows, plowing the fields, picking the crops and irrigating. After meeting and marrying the love of his life, Bobby also began work at the CF&I Steel Mill where he worked as an electrician for 42 years. He also served in the US Army Reserve. Bobby loved to fish, especially at Lake Deweese with his fishing buddy, Mike G., spending time with Joanne traveling the world, volunteering at his church to help make and sell ladyfinger cookies during the festival, tinkering in the garage working on his 53' Chevy, and enjoying fun times dancing, gambling, and traveling with their friends, the "clique". Bobby enjoyed spending time with his family the most during the holidays, always hosting 4th of July, Thanksgiving, and more recently honoring his Italian heritage by hosting the Christmas Eve fish dinner. He was

an avid Broncos fan and was always in support of his great nieces and nephews as they played sports in high school. Bobby will be remembered for his tireless work on the family farm, the way he always said "sangwich," his kindness, and the deep care and love he showed his family and friends. He will be dearly missed by all who knew and loved him. A funeral mass will be held on Monday, December 29th at 11:00AM at St. Joseph Church, 1145 S. Aspen Road, Pueblo, Colorado 81006.
