



## Dr. Robert K Browder

November 1, 1943 - May 4, 2025

Dr. Robert K. Browder (81) of Pueblo went home to be with the Lord on Sunday May 4, 2025. He is preceded in death by his loving wife of 44 years Vickie Browder; and parents, O.C. and Lillian Browder. He is survived by his Daughter, Nicole (Bill) Lobato; son, David (Stephanie) Browder; brother, Leon (Sandy) Browder; grandsons, Zachary Chavez, Jayden Lobato, Austin Lobato; and numerous brothers-in-law, sisters-in-law; and nieces and nephews. Bob as many people knew him by is a native of Pueblo and graduated from East High School in 1961. He then went on to get his bachelor's from Southern Colorado State College (now known as CSU-Pueblo) before heading to Kansas to get his Doctor of Optometry in 1967. Next he joined the Air Force as an officer and was stationed in Kirkland AFB during the Vietnam Era. In 1970 Dr. Browder returned home to Pueblo where he opened his optometry practice and served the community of Pueblo, La Junta, and Canon City for over 47 years. He met his wife Vickie in 1979, and it was love at first sight and they remained married till Vickie passed away last year. Both Bob and Vickie were extremely active at Park Hill Baptist Church where they sang in the choir and helped run the nursery program for many years and Bob served as a deacon. Bob joined his wife in her hobby of collecting and selling antiques which they enjoyed many a weekend going to auctions and yard sales. Bob also enjoyed being part of a bowling league for many years. After retirement he also loved spending time with his grandsons. As many people know Dr. Browder he was a man of few words; however, even in his silence he touched

many lives. Unfortunately, Bob had a rough battle with prostate cancer back in 1993 which he was able to fight back but the last few years the cancer came back, and he was unable to keep fighting. Also, he struggled with dementia for nearly 10 years and lost the ability to speak but still could make people feel welcomed and appreciated just by his actions. What Dr. Browder taught his children is to live by your actions not your words and for that he will always live in our hearts.

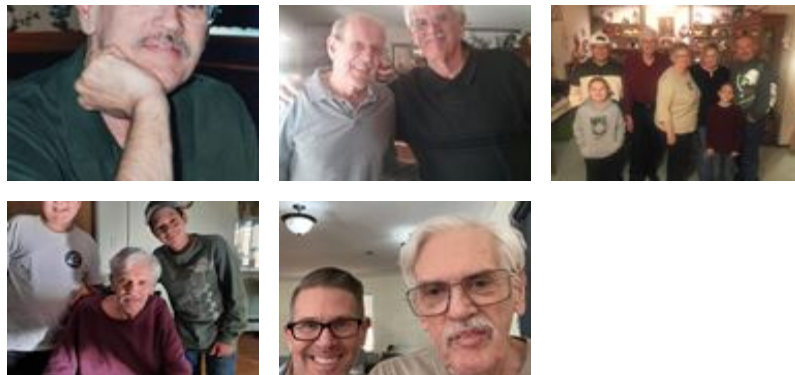
