



## Sam L Corsi

April 13, 1953 - April 10, 2026

Samuel L. Corsi, 72, of Pueblo, Colorado, passed away on April 10, 2026. He was preceded in death by his parents, Samuel G. and Verla Corsi.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 54 years, Kay; daughter Jennifer (Chris) Headley; son Brian (Amy) Corsi; grandson Alex (Kaitlyn) Perez; granddaughters Brianna Perez, Abigail Corsi, Ella Headley, and Lea Corsi; and numerous other relatives.

Born in Denver, Sam grew up in Pueblo, where he met Kay in high school. Their love story spanned 60 years, carrying them through all that life brought their way. From teenage hopes and dreams to raising a family and traveling in their RV wherever their hearts desired, they built a life rooted in love and devotion.

Following careers at Safeway, and owning Corsi's Bowl, Sam spent 20 years working at Wilcoxson Buick as a car salesman, earning Salesman of the Year honors multiple times. Even during his first battle with cancer, he continued selling cars from his hospital room. Following his "retirement," Sam went to work at Brian's insurance agency while Brian was deployed. He stayed for another 12 years, leaving a mark on the agency that will never be replaced. Sam adored his family and cherished time spent at Sunday dinners, game nights, holidays, and his grandchildren's events, he loved it all. He cheered just as loudly for his grandkids as he did for his beloved Broncos and Rockies. Second only to his family, Sam loved sports; both watching and, in his younger years, playing. Winter was for football, and spring through fall were

for baseball. And fall, when both seasons overlapped, was especially glorious. Sam rarely missed his children's sporting events or performances, and he missed even fewer of his grandchildren's. Each of them will remember looking out into the crowd and finding their Papa cheering them on.

Sam will be remembered for all of this and so much more. He will be deeply missed by all who knew and loved him.

A Funeral Mass will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, April 23, 2026, at Christ the King Church in Pueblo, Colorado. A Celebration of Life will follow the Mass at the Pueblo Country Club.
