Mrs. Holman asked to see my test and I showed her. I remember her smile and asking me if I wanted to redo the test with her even though it wouldn't be graded with Mrs. Goddard. Every Friday spelling test I passed with 100% because Mrs. Holman never gave up and helped me get that 100% I remember when Mrs. Holman's Son passed away and a friend from elementary school (that also loved Mrs. Holman) and I went to the services and seeing Mrs. Holman cry was the hardest feeling to handle because she was that super hero in my mind that could never be hurt and could overcome everything. No matter how old I get I will always remember Mrs. Holman as my spelling test super hero. I could go on and on about other memories with Mrs. Holman but the best one and most special is the spelling test memory.
