Thomas A. Webb, born 2/10/1934 passed away 8/13/13 after years of prostate cancer and other infirmities. He is survived by his wife, Ellen Cooney; sons, Daniel and Michael Webb; sister, Judy Mason; granddaughter, Danyelle Webb; and several nieces and nephews. Born and raised in Richmond, Indiana, his travels took him to China and back. First with the Navy during the Korean War then in technical engineering positions with Raytheon and Sikorsky Aircrafts. He worked with computers all the way from vacuum tubes to the advanced Linux and networking courses he taught at Pueblo Community College after retiring as IT/Materials Manager with Dana Corporation's Pueblo plant. He donated endless hours to rehabbing computers with the SEEDS program for donation to schools and nonprofits. Ever the renaissance man, he was also an accomplished artist, photographer, fiction writer, musician and old-time radio fan. His gentle humor and his seemingly endless patience in the face of more than a decade of physical challenges will be sorely missed but still admired.
